

POINT SHOWS – LED & RIDDEN

The 2026/27 Show Season will have FOUR POINT SHOWS for Led & Ridden and you must compete at **two** shows to be eligible for End of Season Awards. Points from **three** shows will count towards awards however points can't be split between events. Points will not be applied until the owner is financial and horse is registered. A horse can only win the overall award if it has won a Supreme, or a Champion if there is no Supreme for that discipline. In the event of a tie, on points, the horse who places highest at the State Championships will be deemed the winner.

All Intermediate Ridden class points go towards the Intermediate Ridden award. All Open Ridden classes go towards the Open Ridden award. The Supreme Ridden points will only be allocated to the Ridden Exhibit of the Year. In the case of the Royal Show, Intermediate and Open horses will gain points in correspondence with their current ridden grading.

POINT SHOWS - HARNESS

Unfortunately, we only have ONE confirmed Harness event so far for this season for carriage horses. We will update you if we manage to find other suitable events to use.

Below are the TWO POINT SHOWS for Harness. You must compete at a minimum of **one** harness show to be eligible for End of Season Awards. Horses can only participate in one section per Point Show (Race Cart OR Carriage). In the event of a tie, on points, the horse who places highest at the last event of the season will be deemed the winner. A horse can only win the overall award if it has won a Supreme.
