An awesome turnout of all exhibitors saw a tough best presented line-up with the eventual award going to the Adina Park Darcy Woods and Kristie Morrone. The mares kicked off a strong class which saw Radial Pie turn the tables to be sashed First and Champion over Crystal Rocket, who at her first Royal was quite overwhelmed by the experience. The small gelding had a couple of withdrawals which just left the two to via for honours. Unfortunately for Watt A Getaway he also found the conditions a bit much and didn't show off his usual movement and filled his workout with a bit of a shuffled pace. Royal Pride on the other hand showed his usual flicky trot to take first place. The bigger gelding class was a strong line up with Baileys Rocket excelling over his rivals to take first over newcomer Notary Pretty Boy. All four geldings re-entered and worked out once more with the bold moving Baileys Rocket taking the Champion over Royal Pride for Reserve. The gelding and mare came together for Supreme and after side profiles it was Baileys Rocket called forward and sashed Supreme Champion for his biggest win to date.

Two classes of three exhibits were presented for judging of the ridden. The small class first up saw once again a horse not handle the atmosphere. Royal Pride warmed up lovely prior to the class but once he got on the big arena his cheeky behaviour got the better of him. Disappointment for his rider, Tracey Cosham but I'm sure the experience will do him great for next year. Likewise Design To NV's young rider Britney DeLaPair, rode beautifully but a few small errors also had her marked down. With that Radial Pie put the best workout together and was placed first of the small group. The bigger height class saw two Royal Show newcomers up against a relatively more seasoned show horse. After workouts it was Adina Park Darcy Woods for first over a vastly improving Cyclone Dilinger for second. The two first placegetters re-entered and worked only on the circle for judging. After a brief workout on each rein they were called back in to line-up. Adina Park Darcy Woods was called forward and sashed Champion Ridden at his second Royal after placing reserve last year. Cyclone Dilinger and Radial Pie were put on the circle and once again come back to line up. Cyclone Dilinger handled the atmosphere perfectly and was sashed Reserve Champion. A great effort at her first year competing at the royal.
