



Stallions Pazam and Admirals Christmas were the standouts from this years Perth Royal Show held in gloomy conditions at the Claremont Show Grounds. On a day where the judge had a fetish for chrome, Pazam was always going to be hard to beat in the opening class, Best Presented Standardbred. With his superb sparkling white markings and iridescent chestnut coat and handler Kristy Padberg once again excelling in the wardrobe department this combination was again victorious at yet another Royal.

The mares class had spectators and no doubt competitors scratching their heads as the judge changed his mind several times before finalising his final placing's. Holmwood Chip leap frogged her rivals in the line up from third to first and taking with her the champion mare title over Kimaley Black Envy, his initial first choice, for reserve. A rather bemused Jackie Series and Dynamite Trunkey must have felt like a yoyo moving from 4<sup>th</sup> to 2<sup>nd</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup>!

The stallion class has Pazam in front after workouts and he looked odds on of a victory until, yes you guessed it, the judge decided a decision is never that easy. After what seemed an eternity of judging on side profile he made the switch over with Admirals Christmas taking champion stallion. Judging between the mare and stallion followed very quickly with the chief ringmaster entering the ring as a drum roll and fanfare highlighted the announcement of Admiral's Christmas as the 2005 Perth Royal Show Supreme Standardbred.

The gelding's class was held in drizzling rain and with a fair indication of what the judge liked, the big Hampton Georgia entered the class a hot favourite and did not disappoint his backers winning the class relatively easily over Kimaley Toyboy and Beefiftytoo.

Pazam continued his good form later in the day winning the ridden standardbred over 15.2hh and came up against the winner of the under height class in Glyding Moments for champion. Neither horse gave an inch in their workouts, with the stallion showing his usual softness to edge out his opponent for Champion Ridden Standardbred Perth Royal 2005. Glyding Moments was a deserving Reserve Champion at his very first Royal Show.

Admiral's Christmas topped off a splendid day in winning the Standardbred Harness Turnout and the Open Standardbred Harness Exhibit. Carol Fawcett with Holmwood Chip won the driver class. Alesha Giles and Beefiftytoo did a remarkable job competing with all the distractions a Royal show can create considering this horse's harness manners some months ago.

***Judges comments taken from Hoofbeats** - Without question, the busiest judge for the breed program was Leigh Dunstan, who agreed to step in and officiate a further seven breeds at the last minute. It was one of the breeds he took on at a later stage, the Standardbreds, he felt deserved a special mention, as he was 'astonished' by the large number of quality exhibits presented and was very impressed with the standard of turnout. He was also pleased with the showmanship and professionalism shown by the handlers, as this was lacking in many other breeds.*

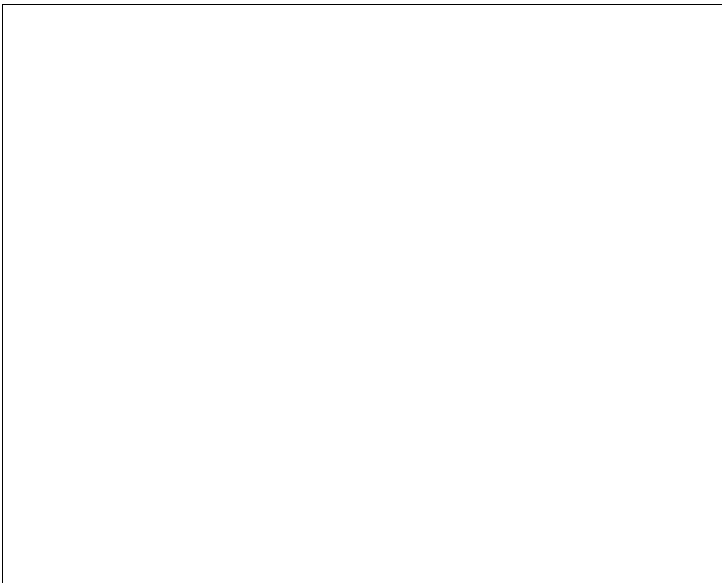

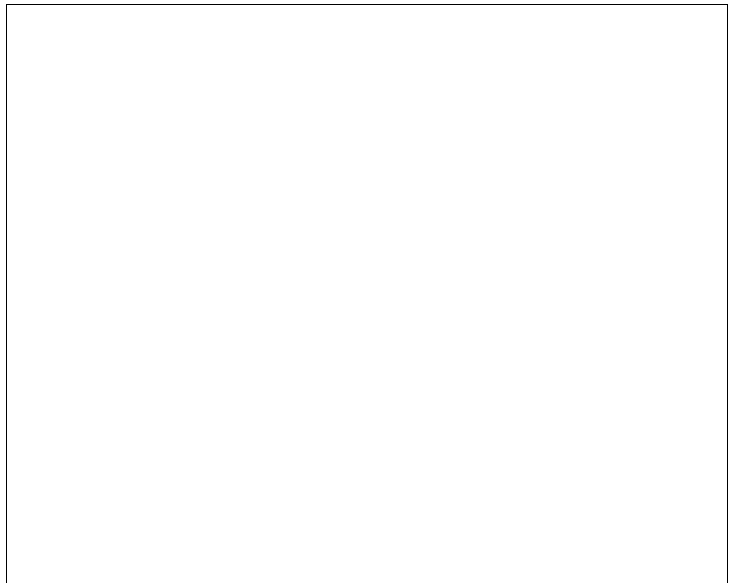
