

POINT SHOWS & HOW TO CALCULATE POINTS

The 2024/25 Show Season will have THREE POINT SHOWS for Led & Ridden. You must compete at **two** shows to be eligible for End of Season Awards however, points from all **three** shows will count. Points will not be applied until the owner is financial and horse is registered. A horse can only win the overall award if it has won a Supreme. In the event of a tie, on points, the horse who places highest at the Dual-Code will be deemed the winner.

All Intermediate Hack class points go towards the Intermediate Hack award. All Open hack classes go towards the Open Ridden award. The Supreme Ridden points will only be allocated to the Ridden Exhibit of the Year.

Any points earned in Junior horse classes will only count towards Junior horse Awards, unless that Junior earns a Champion or Reserve and beats Senior Horses, then those points will be accredited to both Junior and Senior Horse Awards. If there are no seniors present than the Champion/Reserve points will again only be awarded to the Junior Awards. * Junior to be classified as any horse 3 years and under for that current show season.

HARNESS POINT SHOWS

Below are the THREE POINT SHOWS for Harness. You must compete at **two** harness shows to be eligible for End of Season Awards however, points from all **three** shows will count. Horses cannot compete in both sections, It is either Race Cart OR Carriage at any event. In the event of a tie, on points, the horse who places highest at the last event of the season will be deemed the winner.

Champion Standardbred	8 points
Reserve Champion Standardbred	6 points
Individual Age /Gender Class - 1st Place	3 points
2nd Place	2 points
3rd Place	1 point

Calculating Points for Ridden & Harness

Individual ridden or harness classes	1st place – 3 points per class 2nd place – 2 points per class 3rd place – 1 point per class
Champion Ridden/Harness	Extra 10 points
Reserve Champion Ridden/Harness	Extra 6 points
Supreme Ridden\Harness	Extra 2 points
Supreme Ridden\Harness (HOTY)	5 Points
