



After Tuesday deluge of rain, competitors could not have asked for more perfect conditions in providing the defunct new Zealand based stallion Admiral Halsey a treble at this years Perth Royal Show.

The Best Presented was first up and with sixteen immaculate horses and handlers entered it seemed the judge would have his work cut out. After a very thorough judging with gear being checked and handlers under scrutiny etc judge Graham Smith had no hesitation in calling forward the very classy combination of Alesha Giles and Admiral Abernethy.

With only the one entrant in the young filly class Destinydejavu walked away with the blue. The mare class had an array of differently built horses enter the ring, from the tall to the small, long to the short making it an interesting class. It was the very balanced body and workout of Admirals Joylyn who carried on the sire's form on winning Champion mare, halting the back-to-back hopes of Holmwood Chip who was awarded Reserve Champion.

The stallions followed a very similar pattern with Admirals Christmas coming through as Champion and giving his sire Admiral Halsey his third winner for the day. Pazam was awarded second and Reserve Champion Stallion. With full brother and sister facing off for Supreme, it was the overall presence of the stallion that had him awarded Supreme Standardbred for the 3rd running.

The geldings had two height classes this year and the judge seemed to be looking for something different than breeding stock. Although a balanced and good moving horse was still a pre-requisite, the shorter barrelled horses coming through with Glyding Moments and Admiral Abernethy placing first and second respectively in the 15h and under class. Kimaley Toyboy was successful over Lights Of Wembley in the higher height class. The stunning Glyding Moments was awarded with the Champion Gelding sash. Unfortunately, the RAS did not award a Reserve award for this section.

The dream of winning a Royal Show Ridden was accomplished for young rider Lisa Carson when Glyding Moments executed a winning workout after some very anxious moments when a brawl erupted onto the arena just as Lisa and Lombo were to commence their workout. The judge called her back and allowed time for both horse and rider to settle before commencing again. Pazam even though working well for Kristy Padberg and winning his height class, unfortunately couldn't produce his best for the Champion workout. This allowed Amber Kitson and Maximus the opportunity to successfully challenge for the Reserve Champion Ridden award.

Three horses competed in the Harness later in the afternoon and once again were commended for their presentation. Admiral Abernethy and Kristie Morrone were successful in the Turnout and Driver class, while Holmwood Chip and Carol Fawcett won the Open Class. Beefiftytoo worked faultlessly for Alesha Giles and is closing the gap on his rivals with every outing.
